



Barolo - Novello - Monforte

Starting at Barolo, this route allows you to discover Novello. A village distributed across the crest of a hill with splendid views, from here you see all of the Langa to the east and the Tanaro valley to the west. It is worth stopping here to visit the wine shop in the crypt of the San Sebastiano church. The route then continues on to Monforte...



Information

- Length of the route: 7.75 Km
- Duration: 2 hours, 30 minutes
- Starting point: Barolo
- Arrival point: Monforte
- Recommended season: spring, summer, autumn
- Difficulty: 2
- Signs: red and white horizontal stripes

Starting point: piazza Cabutto in Barolo. Go up via Vittorio Veneto and continue along the dirt road that runs halfway up the hillside up until Cascina Foglio. Take the asphalt road on the right and continue up to Novello. Go back down the same stretch of asphalt road past Cascina Foglio again and turn right just after the farmhouse, into a dirt road. After about 300 m go down to the left and continue on until you reach the country road. Turn right at this point and after 200 m turn right again into a path that leads up to the houses of Panerole. Carry on towards Monforte along the asphalt road. Turn left after about 100 m and then after about 50 m turn right onto the path that takes you up to Cascina Zolfo. Carry on straight-ahead until you reach the crest of the hill. From here, take the asphalt road down to Madonna Sette Vie, then turn left and continue up to Monforte.
