

## The Great Tour of Barolo (2<sup>nd</sup> leg: Vergne - Novello - Barolo Castiglione Falletto - Serralunga)

This is a nature-based itinerary that takes you through countryside of incomparable beauty. Here and there you catch glimpses of the natural amphitheatre of undulating hills that characterise the Langhe. It is an area that is famous for producing Barolo wine, which is made using the Nebbiolo grape.





## Information

- Length of the route: 15 Km
- Duration: 4 hours, 45 minutes
- Starting point: Vergne
- Arrival point: Serralunga d'Alba
- Recommended season: spring, summer, autumn
- Difficulty: 2
- Signs: red and white horizontal stripes

Take the road that leads down to the valley floor and after 100 m turn left towards the "Cà San Ponzio", go past it and carry on through the fields to Borgata Pezzole. Descend down to the left onto an asphalt road and then ascend up to Borgata Ciocchini. Turn right near the "Strà" wine company and then continue on the left down a dirt road that leads through fields and vineyards. Keep to the left for two forks in the road and you will arrive near the pharmacy at Novello. Carry on towards the village centre and after 100 m turn left onto an asphalt road in descent. Stay on this road for about 1 km and then turn left onto a dirt road when you reach a group of houses. Carry on halfway up the hill-side with a light descent and fantastic views all the way to Barolo.

From the castle in Barolo go down the steep descent, turn left at the crossroads onto a dirt road and follow it for 600 m. Turn right at the bridge and carry on through the fields until you reach an asphalt road. Turn right onto this road and after 80 m turn left to follow a stream. Turn right when you reach

a junction with three other roads and go up to Castiglione Falletto through the vineyards.

Opposite the "Renza" bar take the small road that descends and follow it for 100 m. Turn right and continue your descent through vineyards until you reach the asphalt road running along the valley floor. Turn right onto this road and follow it for 800 m. Turn left and follow alongside a stream until you reach a gravel road. Turn left here and carry on for 50 m, then turn right and continue for a further 100 m. Go up to the left and carry on until you reach Borgata I Vei then turn left onto an asphalt road and con-tinue on to Serralunga.
